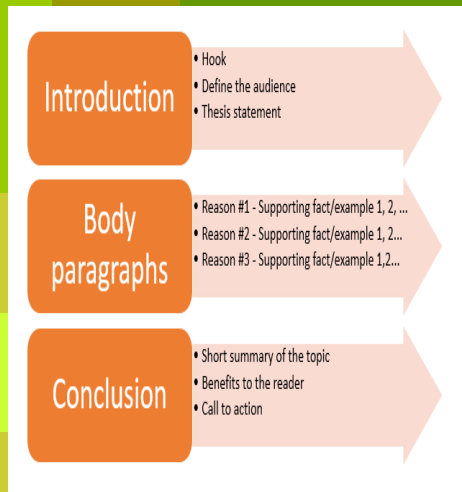


# English Writing/Vocabulary

**Moral Issues**

**eviction** ..... ► to force somebody to leave a place, usually because of bad behaviour

**banishment** ..... ► to send someone away  
► to exile somebody from a place

**expulsion** ..... ► dismissal from a place or membership  
► the act of compelling somebody to leave or give up membership in an institution such as a school usually as a punishment

**panacea** ..... ► a supposed cure for all problems

**jurisdiction** ..... ► the territory over which authority extends

**community** ..... ► a group of people who live in the same area, or the area in which they live  
► the public or society in general

**consistently** ..... ► repeating a particular action

**chronic** ..... ► repeatedly doing something  
► always present or recurring

**dysfunction** ..... ► a failure to function normally or properly

**abuse** ..... ► the physical, psychological, or other maltreatment of a person  
► the illegal, improper, or harmful use of something

**justice** ..... ► fairness or reasonableness, especially in the way people are treated or decisions are made  
► the legal system, or the act of applying or upholding the law

**referendum** ..... ► a vote by the whole of an electorate on a specific question by a governing body

**bylaw** ..... ► a law made by a local government that applies only in that area  
► a rule made by an organization for its members
